

SEARCHING FOR INNOVATIVE WAYS TO CONSOLIDATE EXISTING COOPERATION INSIDE AND BEYOND SCHOOL

Step1: Strong ties initiated in school.

- Between 2013-2018 teachers and students developed and tested in undergraduate classrooms some tools and pedagogical approaches allowing to foster deep understanding in learning, critical mind and creativity (meaningful learning).
- This way of teaching and learning generated solid and sustainable links inside school between teachers and students and encouraged strong commitment.

Step 2: From dreams to acting in school to become actor of his life: AutreSens.

In order to maintain outside school those existing links, to share values and to join forces, students and teachers decided together to create a no governmental organisation, named AutreSens.

Step 3. Strengthening the link: the bet of an horizontal mode of governance. Why?

- To reflect the purposes pursued by the NGO: promoting tools encouraging deep reflexion on complex issues, critical mind, creativity and advocating for strategies that encourage thoughtfulness and social engagement.
- To foster collective intelligence instead of individual.
- To give everyone a chance to participate.
- To avoid classic pitfalls of hierarchical organisations such as communication difficulties, low motivation, and poor distribution of responsibilities.

Preliminary Results

High response rate to the questionnaire: 92% (35 members among 38): significant of a real commitment.


By adopting the 5 rules of collective intelligence:


- Listening Attentively

- Being Respectful


And now?



Eight members answered this open question. Their answers confirm the results mentioned above, among which four are particularly recurrent: maintaining an inclusive environment, adherence to shared values, carrying out projects, and an interest for education in its broad sense. When analysing the results, one new element emerges in a significant way: the dedication of a former teacher that led several members to personal engagement.
