## How to ask

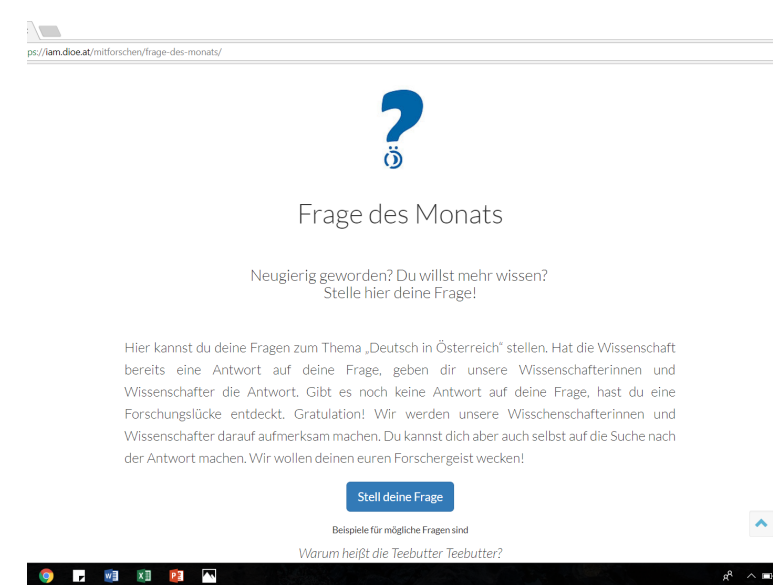
There are various ways for citizens to pose their questions concerning „German in Austria“.

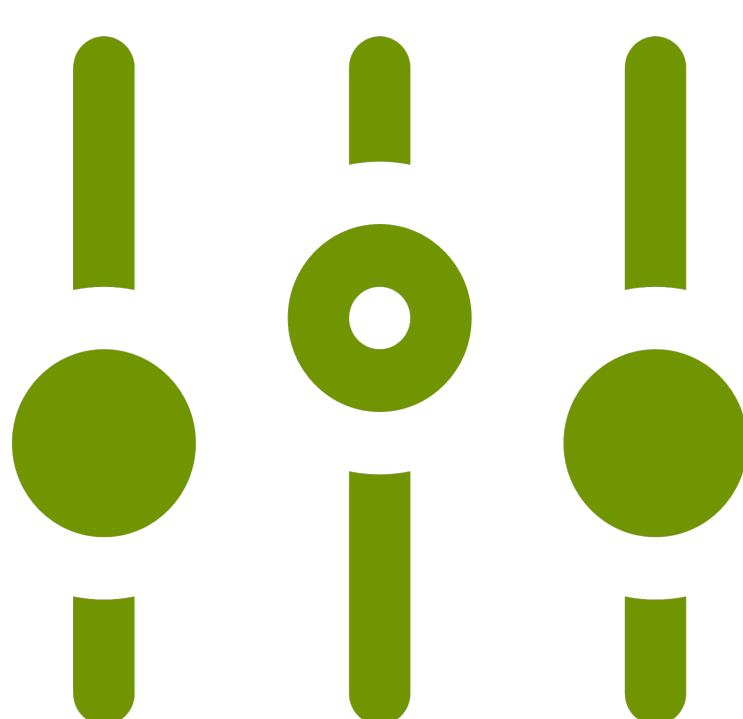
