Why projects would like to participate?

• Visibility

 Connection with spaces (public infrastructures), events (organized by public administration) and several parts of the municipality

• Alliances with other (and different) agents

- Openning a shared census of volunteers (citizen scientists) and external advisors
 - $\circ~$ Identifying needs: infrastructures and new technologies
- Learn from other citizen science projects in a "safe" space
