To support citizen science in Barcelona by promoting projects in the city and its Metropolitan Area. To develop actions for connecting citizens and research

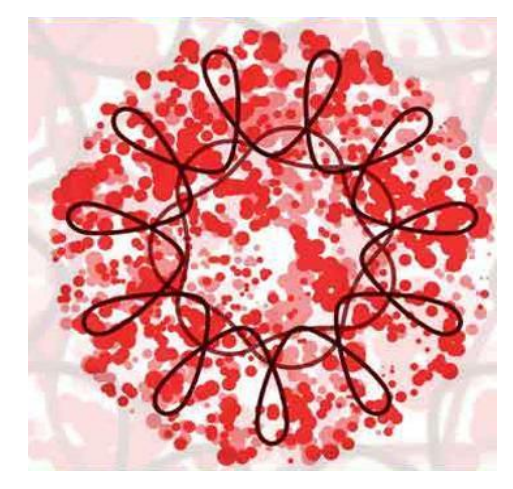
